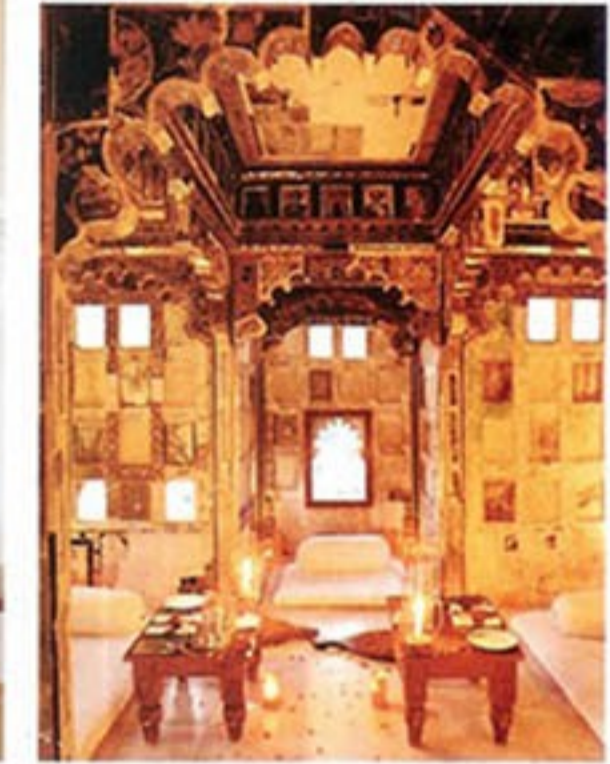
One of the most romantic retreats in the world, and one of India's finest heritage hotels, Devi Garh is
