Jawai Leopard Camp, Rajasthan, India

Not sure you fancy swapping long lie-ins for dawn wake-up calls? Trust us, you will

Out in the desert there are no hotels, towns or even tourists – but don't be fooled into thinking this means no luxe. Because Jawai Leopard Camp is not camping as we know it – this is camping that's cool for cats! A synergy of super-cool Louis Vuitton meets Indian colonial-era-style interiors and luxury African-style safari camp, the eight-tented suites of white canvas on platforms of black slate have contemporary chrome-framed beds. Just roll out the mosquito nets and leave the tent flaps open to let in the romance of the desert night.

Once you know you're in safely stylish surroundings, you can get on with the wildlife spotting. Dawn and dusk drives through the spectacular landscape of ancient temples, sweeping fields of mustard yellow and winding river beds almost guarantee leopard sightings. And because this is natural wilderness, rather than a designated park, there are also guided walks, mountain biking and night drives. After satiating your safari appetite, chill out by the infinity pool or sit on your private terrace. Lunch can be anything from fabulous salads of tabouleh, houmous and fresh leaves, to Rajasthani curries. End the day with a candle-lit dinner around an open fire in the moonlit wilderness.
